apéritif . stimulate your appetite

kopke dry white port . douro, portugal 6.50

white port? yes, indeed- spicy with rich flavors of banana, apricots and orange zest with a slightly sweet, nutty character...give it a go on the rocks with a splash of soda... it might be your new favorite...

lillet blanc . podensac, france 6.50

since its creation in 1887, lillet is the only apéritif made in bordeaux...through it's long history, the recipe has changed a bit, and the current manifestation is a blend of wine, fruit liqueurs, fruit and fruit peels aged for up to one year in oak... soft and appealing, floral and citrusy with just a hint of astringency on the finish... served on the rocks with a twist of orange...

cocchi americano . asti, italy 6.50

this apéritif is for those that appreciate lillet, but want a little more spice in their lives. the cocchi recipe has been produced faithfully since 1891—moscato is aromatized with herbs, fruit, spices and cinchona bark—which is the source of the quinine that gives this beverage it's wonderfully cleansing finish... served on the rocks with a splash of soda and an orange twist...

domaine de joÿ . floc de gascogne, france 6.50

though it has been the traditional apéritif in armagnac since the 17th century, it wasn't until 1954 when a winemaker named henri lamor gave it the name "floc de gascogne", or "bouquet of flowers"...(incidentally, it wasn't until 1976 that it was even legal to sell floc de gascogne)... during harvest, fresh grape juice is blended with young armagnac brandy...the result is an apéritif brimming with the flavors of honey, oranges, bananas and almonds...served chilled...

tariquet 'l'apéritif' . éauze, france 7.00

for all intents and purposes, the tariquet l'apéritif is a floc de gascogne, however the tariquet family has a history of willingly eschewing tradition...if you open your experience with a glass of the l'apéritif, might we suggest you finish it with a snifter of their 100% folle blanche armagnac (page 74)...

dolin dry vermouth . chambéry, france 6.50

dolin was founded in 1821, and has been using the same recipe ever since... by using quality wine from the savoy with a mixture of 54 plants and herbs found in the meadows above chambéry, they create a distinctively light, floral and elegant vermouth suitable for sipping on the rocks...really...it's not just for martinis...

via extra dry vermouth . madera, california 7.00

the genesis of vermouth dates back to the 1700s...consider andrew quady's modern update a re-birth...It will elevate a martini, for certain-though enjoyed simply on the rocks is the best way to experience its beguiling mixture of floral, herbal and citrus flavors...

apéritif . stimulate your appetite

toro albalá 'fino eléctrico' . montilla-moriles, spain 8.00

if you are a fan of dirty martinis, here's something for you to try:
a dry pedro ximénez from the white albariza soils of the toro albalá estate...
there is something about the flavor profile of this apertif—olives and sea salt—that convinced us to serve this wine chilled, in a martini glass, with a couple of olives.

argüeso amontillado sherry . sanlucar de barrameda, spain 9.00

sherry is not just for old british ladies at bridge club...if you're looking for something tangy and nutty to electrify the palate and take you into your first course, this is the wine...served chilled...

dubonnet rouge . bardstown, kentucky 6.50

made to the specifications of the original french formula created in 1846, red wine grapes harvested in the south of france are flavored with a secret blend of spices with a touch of quinine...served on the rocks with an orange twist...

bonal gentiane-quina . st. laurent-du-pont, france 6.50

known as "ouvre l'appétit"—the key to the appetite...the infusion of gentian root and quinine supply the cleansing properties, and herbs from the grand chartreuse mountains supply the myriad of flavors in this unique and complex elixer... the quinine, by the way, contains properties that destroy the plasmodiums that cause malaria...served chilled...

carpano antica formula . torino, italy 7.00

if you'd like to step into a flavor time machine, the original formula for this beverage was developed in 1786 by antonio benedetto carpano, who was also said to be the inventor of vermouth. (can you imagine a world without the martini?) according to lore, demand for this elixer eventually forced him to keep his shop open 24 hours a day...which is only hard to believe if you've never had it. served on the rocks. it will change your life.

campari . milano, italy 8.00

the secret recipe for this rather bracing beverage has been made faithfully since 1860, based on the specifications created by gaspare campari—who was not only a master drink maker, but one of the first marketing geniuses. early in its history, proprietors could access his bottles only if they agreed to also display a campari sign at their bars. eventually, campari melded art and commerce by commissioning poster and calendar creations from international painters and illustrators—a development that forever changed advertising... but it never would've lasted 150 years if it wasn't one of the world's greatest aperitifs. have it on the rocks with an orange...

they haven't (yet) coined the marketing term for our home-grown blends, but these wines are the combination of classic bordeaux and rhône valley varietals.

in the past decade and half, there has been a renaissance of sorts in portugal.

no longer tethered by outdated and constrictive wine laws of the past, growers and producers have started to diversify from traditional fortified wines into dynamic and unique still wines. in these wines, you will find traditional port varietals (touriga nacional, touriga franca, tinta barroca, trincadeira) being showcased as still wines, and often blended with more “mainstream” grapes (cabernet sauvignon, syrah).

needless to say, these are wines that are as exciting as they are original.

in 1854, the friars of st. spiritos abbey presented to their justice and benefactor, salvatore averna, a gift—a unique elixir infused with herbs, roots, flowers, bark, orange peel, and alcohol. four generations later, the averna amaro remains a family business...il gusto pieno della vita!!

fernet-branca . 8

twenty-seven herbs picked in four continents and aged in oak for a year, this grape-based digestif is a little hard to pin down...it is as much a revitalizing medicine as it is a beverage—but be warned: it's not so subtle...

green chartreuse . 10

the recipe for this distinct liquid is known by only three chartreuse monks who oversee its production and maturation. it's said that over 130 different plants are used...some like it neat, but we find it most pleasing on the rocks

pastis . 8

when absinthe was banned in france 1915, pastis was created...add a little sugar... add a little water...

kübler absinthe . 12.50

but if you'd like to do real thing, the 95 year ban on absinthe has been partially lifted...please keep in mind, however, that it is still listed by the DEA under the nomenclature of "drugs and chemicals of concern"...

it's safe to say that grappa has garnered a rather negative reputation over the years...(it was not uncommon to hear it referred to as "kerosene" or "italian moonshine" back in the day...) but times change, and at this point in history we are enjoying a new wave of craft grappa from both italy and america... for the uninitiated, grappa is the result of distilling all the leftover material produced from winemaking—aka "the pomace"—grape skins, seeds, and stems. perhaps the world's finest recycling gesture, grappa is a potent pleasure best left until the end...

soft tail spirits 'blanco' . yakima valley, washington . 12
(merlot, syrah, cabernet sauvignon)

it was illegal to distill booze in the state of washington until the summer of 2008, and soft tail spirits was the first legal operatoin in western washington... their 'blanco' grappa has an uncanny tequila-like profile...

clear creek distillery . portland, oregon . 9
(muscat)

clear creek distillery has been producing grappa and other spirits for a quarter century...their muscat grappa is full of flowers and spice, and might be the best choice for those new to the grappa game...

germain-robin . north coast, california . 18
(syrah)

this grappa is made by hand in an old cognac still by a man whose familyhas been in the distillation business since 1782...only produced in small batches using premium grapes, the process takes almost a year, and the resulting liquid is what we sneak into the glasses of those that claim to not like grappa...

alexander 'platinum' . amarone, italy . 10
(corvina veronese, rondinella, molinara)

the alexander comes from the veneto region of italy—the birthplace of grappa... using the pomace from both amarone and its dessert wine sibling, recioto di amarone, the alexander is a suprisingly soft with all sorts of spice and perfume...

g. bertagnoli . piana rotaliana, italy . 9
(teroldego)

four generations of the bertagnoli family have produced grappa from the pomace of teroldego grapes in the trentino alto adige region of italy...and while one might expect an old-fashioned style of from a 140 year old distillery, the bertagnoli is a suprsingly delicate, complex, and modern grappa...

jacopo poli . schiavon, italy . 25
(moscato)

so this glorious liquid is hard to define...technically speaking, it's an immature brandy... or it's grappa on steroids... while most grappa involves the skins, seeds and stems left from the winemaking process, this crystal clear and heady sipper is produced using whole muscat grapes from a single vineyard and vintage...

brandy

the word “brandy” is derived from the dutch word “brandywijn”, translated literally as “burnt wine”. it’s a rather broad category of booze, and it encompasses not only spirits distilled from wine, but fruits as well. that said, the majority of the following selections are made with wine—in fact it takes approximately ten bottles of wine to make one bottle of brandy...

cognac

surrounding the town of cognac, france, are vineyards planted to ugni blanc, folle blanche and colombard...and it is from these humble grapes that the world’s benchmark of brandy is produced...

armagnac

always in the shadow of cognac, armagnacs are for those seeking a little more zing in their snifter. in other words, the kid has a bit more bombast. think quiet after-dinner discussion of shakespearean sonnets (cognac) versus rowdy but well-phrased arguments concerning the origin of man (armagnac).

leriche . vsop . 9

tariquet ‘folle blanche’ . 12

brandy

while hitch-hiking through northern california in the summer of 1981, hubert germain-robin was picked up by ansley coale. long story short, the result of this meeting was an antique still making its way from cognac to coale’s ranch in mendocino county...

the revolution was making brandy out of world-class grape varieties rather than the traditional grapes of cognac. the result is one of the finest brandies you’ll find...

germain-robin ‘fine alembic’ . lot 24 . 10

spain also has a long history of brandy production...established in 1730, the following brandy was what hemingway was drinking in *the sun also rises*...

fundador ‘solera reserva’ . brandy de jerez . 8

calvados

it’s made from apples, and it’s known as “the norman holemaker”, since it is an excellent digestif, and is made in normandy, france. in the event that you indulged in a bit too much consumption of solids, here is the solution:

boulard ‘grande solage’ . 9

cocktail #1: the old fashioned

really—it's one of america's oldest cocktails...your great-grandfather used to drink them at the pendennis club in louisville...and yet, when's the last time you tried one? we'll make you one with maker's mark.

cocktail #2: the martini

be forewarned: your martini will have a dose of vermouth, as was intended by those that created it...and, well, vermouth is fortified wine...and this is a wine bar...

cocktail #3: the manhattan

ok...so rumor has it that the manhattan was invented at a party hosted by winston churchhill's mother...it really must have been quite a party...bourbon, bitters and sweet vermouth shaken and strained...

cocktail #4: the rob roy

if you take your manhattan and trade bourbon for scotch, you've got a rob roy. historically, rob roy is known both as folk hero and an outlaw...we prefer you sip on one of these and aspire to the former.

cocktail #5: the sidecar

the history of this drink involves an american army captain in paris during world war one who was astute enough to always arrive and depart the bar via motorcycle sidecar...we like to make ours with metaxa.

cocktail #6: the negroni

feeling a little bitter? well, bitterness loves company, and there is no better bitter way to cleanse one's palate than a helping of camillo negroni's favorite florentine beverage...seriously...it's not for the faint of heart, and it is better than brushing your teeth.

cocktail #7: the sazerac

invented in new orleans just about 150 years ago...in fact, some trace the name "cocktail" to the very glass used to serve the original sazerac...which means that if you want to get back to your roots, order a sazerac immediately. We prepare our sazeracs with rittenhouse straight rye, by the way, and if you've never had one: it's like a costume party in a glass.

google 'brandy alexander' and you get a hard rock band from greensboro, a professional female wrestler and a whole lot of homepages belonging to girls named brandy...drinking a brandy alexander, however, beats the internet any day.

cocktail #12: the pastis

before you order this, ask christene to talk you into it...if she's not around to do the job, just close your eyes and imagine yourself at a paris sidewalk café with a fascinating companion and a copy of *a moveable feast* in your back pocket...

cocktail #13: the long island iced tea . 10

so you've had a long island iced tea before...well, this is much the same—only we use nothing but premium liquors to put ours together...

the classic champagne cocktail

people will argue about the true recipe...fact is, the bartenders that started calling their creations “champagne cocktails” aren’t around to testify, so we’re going with the old stand-by—bitters, sugar, and bubbles with a twist of lemon.

the alfonso

so there’s a whole gaggle of variations on the classic champagne cocktail, but this is one that we all rather liked...the addition of dubonnet (a red wine apéritif from france) adds an aromatic burst and a little spicy edge...

kir royale

you’ve maybe ordered and consumed a “kir royale”, but if it wasn’t produced with real crème de cassis—you got ripped off...ours consists of bubbles with a splash of trénel crème de cassis de bourgogne...

purple royale

clear creek distillery in portland makes a lovely, intense liqueur using loganberries (a hybrid of raspberries and blackberries)...we use it to make a distinctly northwest version of the kir royale...

the french 75

as in 75mm guns used by the french during world war one...seriously...sipped by officers just before battle...gin, fresh squeezed lemon juice (lightly sweetened) with the addition of bubbles...bang...

cold duck

the deal with this champagne cocktail is that if you order it, you have to drink it...it is a strange and beguiling concoction for the adventurous...two parts red wine (we use a classic bordeaux rouge) and three parts sparkling with just a touch of added sweetness...

black velvet rasputin

back in 1861, the nation of england was mourning the death of prince albert, and a rather empathetic barman decided that even the champagne should wear black...our drink is not so dour—old rasputin russian imperial stout married with an equal part bubbles...incidentally, a top-notch hangover cure...

the sally bowles

it’s not a pre-requisite to have seen Cabaret, though it does give some insight into the drink...german ice wine is mixed with st. germain elderflower liqueur, a splash of sweetness and topped off with sparkling wine...divine decadence, indeed...

cocktails with bubbles

mimosa

though most everybody knows that a mimosa is orange juice and bubbles, we thought it prudent to mention that we get to use fresh orange juice in ours...

d'artagnan

if you can come up with the names of the musketeers (without the aid of your internet ready cellular device), we just may buy you one...though if you can also come up with the author, then we might really have to buy you one...
by the way, if one were to spruce up a mimosa with some armagnac and grand marnier, one would ostensibly have themselves a d'artagnan...

the griffin

the tuscarora mill in leesburg virginia has been around since 1899, and this is one of their concoctions—though jim probably didn't know that when he suggested mixing red pineau des charentes with sparkling wine...

champagne antoine

antoine's (new orleans) is america's oldest family run restaurant (1840), and it's said that they invented oysters rockefeller...seems they also came up with this vexing mixture of gin, dry vermouth, pernod and champagne...

the american flyer

while nobody can tell us why it's called an american flyer, we can assure you that it's unsafe to operate any manner of aviation related machinery after drinking one of these...fresh lime juice and white rum placed in a flute rimmed with sugar, then finished off with some bubbles...

the moulin rouge

if you're a fan of early 90s british comedies, then you might know this as the "bolli-stoli" that patsy and edina used to drink in excess...ours is a more humble mixture of stolichnaya and sparkling wine...not the most elegant idea, for certain—but a fast track to feeling absolutely fabulous...

the horn of plenty

we rather like the idea of a horn filled with inexhaustible gifts and celebratory fruits...but since that isn't available, perhaps a blend of campari and grand marnier in a flute of sparkling wine will suffice...?

sea captain's special

it seems a shame to sacrifice a bottle of champagne on the bow of newly minted seafaring vessels...

better to save the bottle, throw in some rye, a bit of pastis and enjoy...

oh, and because the water is sometimes rough, this one's served on the rocks in a very stable glass...

glossary of terms

glossary of terms

acid: acids are important in wine, they make the wine more refreshing and rid the wine of harmful bacteria. it is truly a mouth-watering experience.

adelaide hills: south australian wine region, cool climate, known for sauvignon blanc

a.o.c.: an abbreviation for appellation d'origine contrôlée; the french government agency that controls wine production

aligoté: the 'other' white grape of burgundy, important ingredient for a kir, just add blackberry liqueur

anthocyanins: natural phenolics responsible for the color of black and red grapes

auslese: a german quality wine category, made from selected bunches of late-picked grapes. a riesling auslese can last for decades!

a.v.a.: an abbreviation for american viticultural area

barolo: a beautiful town and a very powerful, yet supple red wine, made from the nebbiolo grape in northwest italy

beaujolais: a light, fruity red wine from the region of beaujolais, france; made from the gamay grape

blanc de blancs: a white wine made from white grapes

blanc de noir: a white wine made from red grapes

botrytis cinerea: a beautifully ugly mold that forms on the grapes, in humid climates, known also as "noble rot" makes sublime dessert wines

boxes, wine: check the expiration date

brix: a scale that measures the sugar level of the unfermented grape juice (must)

brunello di montalcino: a high quality, heavenly red wine made with the tuscan sun and sangiovese grosso

brut: one of the driest styles of champagne, about 16 grams of sugar per liter

cabernet franc: the daddy of cabernet sauvignon, at home in the loire valley and one of the five grapes in a left bank bordeaux

cabernet sauvignon: the most sought after red grape in the world, known for its structure, power and ageworthiness. expresses itself best in bordeaux and california

d.o.c.: an abbreviation for denominazione de origine controllata; the italian government agency that controls wine production

d.o.c.g.: an abbreviation for denominazione de origine controllata e garantita; the italian government allows this marking to appear only on the finest wines. the "g" stands for "guaranteed"

dolcetto: a soft, fleshy red grape from piedmont, italy, that is lighter in style than a barolo or barbaresco

estate-bottled: a wine that's made, produced & bottled by the winery's owner

extra dry: actually, a somewhat sweeter sparkling wine, than the brut style

fermentation: the process by which the sugars in the grape must are being devoured by wine yeasts, which in turn creates alcohol and carbon dioxide

fino: the driest, most delicate of sherries; serve chilled with almonds and shellfish

fortified wine: a wine such as port, that has an arrested fermentation by the addition of grape spirit/brandy to leave a little sugar and raise the alcohol

gamay: a fruity, thin-skinned red grape used in the beaujolais region of burgundy

gewürztraminer: "flowers, bitter oranges, lychee nuts" words used to describe this special white grape. grown mainly in eastern france, germany and western usa

glycerol: a product of alcoholic fermentation, gives wine a smoothness and weight. a minor contribution to the "tears/legs" on the glass

grand cru: the highest classification for a cru, or vineyard, in burgundy

graves: a region in bordeaux, france. home to the first-growth, château haut brion

grenache: the most widely planted red grape of the rhône valley, france. white pepper, strawberries and earth add backbone to the blends

halbtrocken: the german term meaning "semi-dry"

hermitage: perhaps the greatest syrah in the world, from the rhône valley, france

kabinett: the lightest of german whites, semi-sweet. picked earlier than other quality levels, the next ripest being spätlese

margaux: a village & district in bordeaux, france. home to first-growth château margaux, the most feminine of the top bordeaux

médoc: a district in bordeaux, france, encompassing all the greatest châteaux

merlot: the soft, cherry red grape grown primarily in the bordeaux region of france, california & washington state

méthod champenoise: a term no longer used to describe the traditional method of making sparkling wine from the champagne region of france

meursault: a village in the côte de beaune in burgundy, france

microclimate: a term that refers to an area that has a climate within a climate. while one area may be generally warm, it may have a cooler "microclimate" or region

mosel-saar-ruwer: a famous wine-producing region in germany that grows the most breath-taking rieslings in the world

muscadet: a cool climate region and a light, dry wine from the melon de bourgogne grape, in loire valley, france

glossary of terms

must: the thick juice of wine grapes just before alcoholic fermentation

nebbiolo: a red grape grown in piedmont, italy, which produces some of the finest italian wine, such as barolo & barbaresco

nose: the term used to describe the bouquet & aroma of wine

nuits-st-georges: a village in the côte de nuits in burgundy, france. known for some very happy, ethereal pinot noir

paulliac: a village & district in the bordeaux, france, boasting three of the five first-growths

petite sirah: a small, yet thick-skinned red grape grown primarily in california, originally known as durif in the rhône valley, france—the original teethstainer

pfalz: a quality wine region in germany

piedmont: a region in northwest italy, one of the most important, holds the towns of barolo and barbaresco

pinot blanc: a medium-bodied white grape grown primarily in the alsace region of france

pinot grigio: the most popular white wine from italy made from the grape variety called pinot grigio, a.k.a. pinot gris in france

pinot meunier: a red grape grown primarily in the champagne region of france

pinot noir: a fragile red grape that is difficult to grow, but is now the most requested red grape in the world. the red grape of burgundy and northern oregon

pomerol: a district in the bordeaux region of france, known for the world's greatest merlots

pommard: a village in the côte de beaune, france, creates powerful pinot noirs

pouilly-fuissé: a region in mâconnais, france, creates delicious chardonnay

pouilly-fumé: a region known for sauvignon blanc in the loire valley, france

parellada: a spanish white grape, used in the blend for making sparkling cavas

puligny-montrachet: a village in the côte de beaune, france, amazing chardonnays

qualitätswein: a german term meaning “quality wine”

residual sugar: sugars remaining in the finished wine

rheingau: a grape growing region in southern germany, producing rieslings that will bring tears to your eyes

riesling: the white grape. incredible dry, and completely luscious sweet, capable of ageing for decades. grown primarily in alsace, germany & australia

rioja: wine region in spain, famous for reds from the tempranillo and garnacha grape

rosé: a wine with a slight pinkish hue, made from red grapes, where the juice merely passes over the skins. most are very dry, with a delicious raspberry, rhubarb taste

sancerre: a town known for incredible sauvignon blancs from the loire valley, france

sangiovese: a red grape grown primarily in tuscan, italy

sauternes: the most expensive sweet white wine from the bordeaux region of france

sauvignon blanc: a white grape, very versatile, depending on where it is grown. classically, it is known for grapefruit, lime and mineral notes. in riper vintages, it is lovingly referred to as, “cat pee on a gooseberry bush”

sémillon: a white grape found primarily in the graves & sauternes regions of bordeaux, france

shiraz: a red grape grown primarily in australia, a.k.a. syrah

spätlese: a german wine quality term, a wine made from grapes picked later than the normal harvest

st-émilion: a charming town in the bordeaux region of france, also producing some of the most famous bordeaux that are based on merlot

st-estèphe: a village & northern most district in the médoc region of bordeaux, france

st-julien: a village & district in the médoc region of bordeaux, france

syrah: a smoky, spicy red grape grown primarily in the rhône valley region of france, washington & california. known as shiraz in australia and south africa

tannin: a natural compound & preservative that comes from the skins, stems & pips of the grapes & also from the wood in which wine is aged

tawny port: a port that is lighter, nuttier & aged longer in cask than a ruby port

tempranillo: a red grape grown primarily in spain, the backbone to a great rioja

trebbiano: a white grape grown in italy, also known as ugni blanc in france. the main ingredient in cognac and armagnac

tuscany: a great wine region in italy, holds the great towns and wines of chianti classico and brunello di montalcino

varietal wine: a wine that is labeled with the predominant grape used to produce the wine, i.e., a wine made from chardonnay grapes would be labeled “chardonnay”

vintage: the year the grapes are harvested

glossary of terms

viognier: a white grape from the Rhône valley region of France. bursting with white lilies, peaches and perfume

vouvray: a region in the Loire valley, France; it can be dry, semi-sweet or sweet from the Chenin Blanc grape

zinfandel: a juicy red grape that is grown all over California; Primitivo in Italy
